Nine Kilpatrick Townsend Attorneys Recognized on the 2021 Capital Pro Bono Honor Roll

WASHINGTON, D.C. (June 9, 2022) – Kilpatrick Townsend & Stockton announced today that nine attorneys in the firm's Washington, D.C. office received recognition on the 2021 Capital Pro Bono Honor Roll. The honor is awarded by D.C. Courts, in partnership with the D.C. Access to Justice Commission and the D.C. Bar Pro Bono Center.
