Kilpatrick Townsend Plays Key Role at National Bar Association's 2015 Corporate Leadership Forum

SAN DIEGO (July 27) -- The **National Bar Association's (NBA) Corporate Leadership Forum (CLF)** was held on July 18th in Los Angeles, California. The forum is the official kick-off of the NBA's 90th Annual Convention. Partner **Kandace Patton Watson** represented Kilpatrick Townsend and served as a featured moderator at the forum.

Ms. Watson moderated, "Master Class: A Conversation with a Fortune 500 CEO," that featured Kaiser Permanente CEO, Bernard Tyson and General Counsel Mark Zemelman.
